

# Chinese-English Translation Scholarships 2022-23

Five scholarships of £3,000 each are available to international students on our Chinese Translation and Interpreting programmes in the Department of Language and Linguistics. These scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic merit.

## Terms and conditions

### 1. Eligibility

In order to be eligible for this scholarship you must:

- Hold a conditional offer of admission to one of the Chinese-English Translation and Interpreting courses for the academic year 2022-23, including but not exclusive to the following ones
  - MA Chinese-English Translation and Professional Practice
  - MA Conference Interpreting and Translation (Chinese English)
  - MA Advanced Interpreting with Specialised Translation (Chinese-English)
  - PG Diploma in Chinese-English Translation
- Applicants must register and be studying at Essex in 2022-23.
- These scholarships are restricted to international applicants who are entirely self-funded.
- This scholarship is available for the first year of Masters study only
- Successful applicants should be available for promotional activities.

### 2. Students who are not eligible

The following students are NOT eligible for the Chinese / English Translation Scholarship regardless of meeting the above criteria:

- Students who are fully or partly sponsored.
- These scholarships do not apply to deferred entry. Where a student, to whom a scholarship has been offered and requests deferred entry, the award will be considered again in line with the terms and conditions that apply in the new proposed year of entry.

### 3. How to apply

All our relevant course applications, received by the given deadline (31st May 2022), will automatically be considered for this scholarship. You do not need to complete a separate application form.

### 4. Selection process

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic excellence and interview performance, and the final selection is made by a panel of academic and administrative staff of the University of Essex. We will use the information you provide on your original course application to make our selection. Receipt of the scholarship is subject to applicants firmly accepting the offer of study, registering as students of the University of Essex for the 2022-23 academic year, and meeting all conditions of our offer. No alternative form of the scholarship is available, and the award cannot be deferred to a later year from the one for which you are admitted.

## **5. Successful applications**

Successful candidates will normally be notified by end of June 2022 by our Funding Team.

## **6. Scholarship payment**

The scholarships will be awarded in the form of a discount on tuition fees for the 2022-23 academic year only and cannot be deferred to a later year or a different course from those specified above. You will be required to pay any balance of tuition fees from personal or other funds.

## **7. Combining with other awards**

You may only receive one award administered by the University of Essex. In the event that you are offered this award, but are already in receipt of another University award (including the Alumni Loyalty Discount), the larger of the two awards will be kept and the other released.

## **8. Resolution of disputes**

Acceptance of this award constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions. Registered students should contact the [Student Funding Team](#) in the first instance for guidance regarding this award. In cases not covered by the above terms and conditions, or where a student claims exceptional circumstances, or disputes a decision not to make payments due under an award, final appeals on decisions regarding eligibility must be made via the [Student Complaints process](#). The Academic Registrar or his/her nominee will review the case and his/her decision will be final.
